Sadami Yazaki establishes Yazaki densen Eigyo-bu as a joint stock company

1941

Yazaki Electrical Wire Industrial Co. Ltd. is established with about 70 employees

1959

Foundation of Yazaki Parts Co. Ltd. in Japan

1974

Sadami Yazaki passes away suddenly at the age of 64, Yasuhiko Yazaki assumes the presidency

1986

Establishment of a R&D Centre in Cologne

1998

Y-CITY is opened in Susono City, centralizing head office functions

2004

Yazaki incorporates the OLED technology into the Aston Martin's DB9 instrumentation cluster and infotainment control module

2016

The PowerYZer (Type 2 Charger) is presented to the public for the first time at the IZB in Wolfsburg

1929

Sadami Yazaki begins sellings wire harnesses for automobiles as a one-man business

1939

Expansion of business with the establishment of Tokyo Automotive Electric Wire Factory

1949

Sadami Yazaki decides to focus on the production of wire harnesses

1962

1997

2014
